Water main, pipe equipment, parts, truck availability. Cement powder has went up 20%. Rebar and mesh prices have increased dramatically. Stone prices have increased dramatically and now the material producers, Hansen, Vulcan & Lafarge have a work stoppage with Local 150. As of June 10, 2022 both sides are scheduled to meet at 1:00 PM. Hopefully a settlement is reached. NIMPA (Northern Illinois Material Producers) reached a settlement the evening of June 9, 2022. I'm hearing from Redi-Mix Concrete producers that residential work is staring to slow down.
